Adrian Covic is a Professor of Nephrology and Internal Medicine at the “Gr.T. Popa” University of Medicine, Director of the Nephrology Clinic, Dialysis and Transplantation Centre in Iasi, Romania. He is a currently vice-rector with research at the “Gr. T. Popa” University Iasi

Professor Covic started his clinical and research activity as a fellow in Nephrology in Manchester, UK and in Amiens, France. Later he conducted clinical research at the Case Western University in Cleveland, Ohio. He received a PhD on cardiovascular abnormalities and its determinant factors in chronic renal failure in 1997. Since 2007, he has been a Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians, London, and in 2013 became a member of the Romanian Academy of Medical Sciences.

Professor Covic has published more than 230 original and review papers in peer-reviewed journals, 12 books and 22 book chapters. He is a Associate Editor for *Nephrology Dialysis Transplantation*, Editor-in-Chief Nephrology for *The International Journal of Urology and Nephrology*, and editor/reviewer for several other prestigious journals.

His main areas of interest are: cardiovascular complications in renal disease, renal anaemia, chronic kidney disease-mineral bone disorder, continuous ambulatory peritoneal dialysis and acute renal failure.

Professor Covic is the past president of the Romanian Society of Nephrology and former Secretary/Treasurer of the European Renal Association/European Dialysis and Transplant Association (ERA-EDTA). He is currently a board member of Kidney Disease: Improving Global Outcomes (KDIGO) and European Renal Best Practice.
